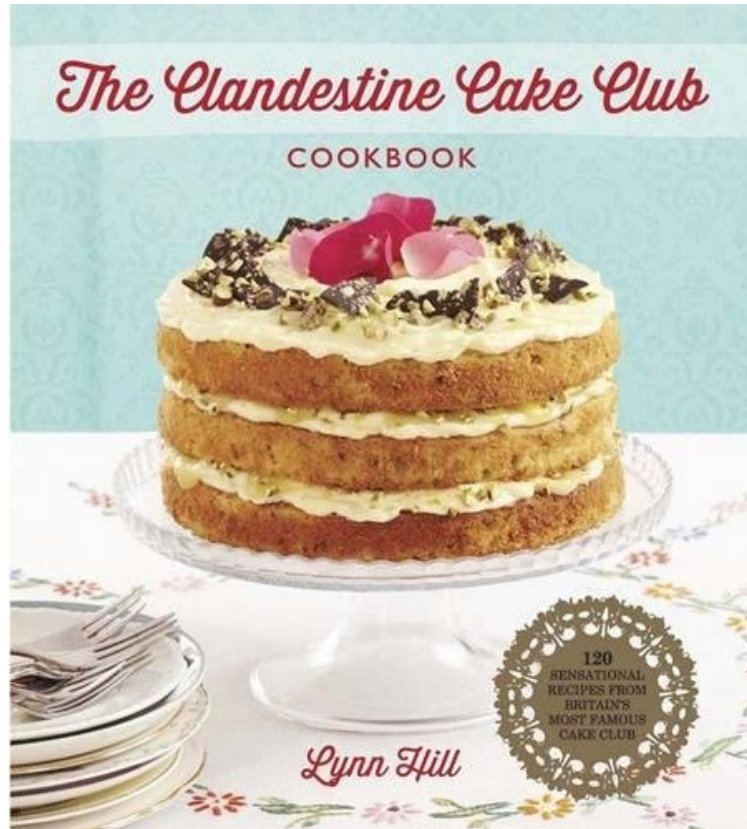

Since I have a digital scale, it is easy to just set it to grams and it then it doesn't matter that I have no idea how much sugar 180g is. Some more popular baking books come out with American editions, but the math is often wrong on the conversions, and this sounded to good to wait.
