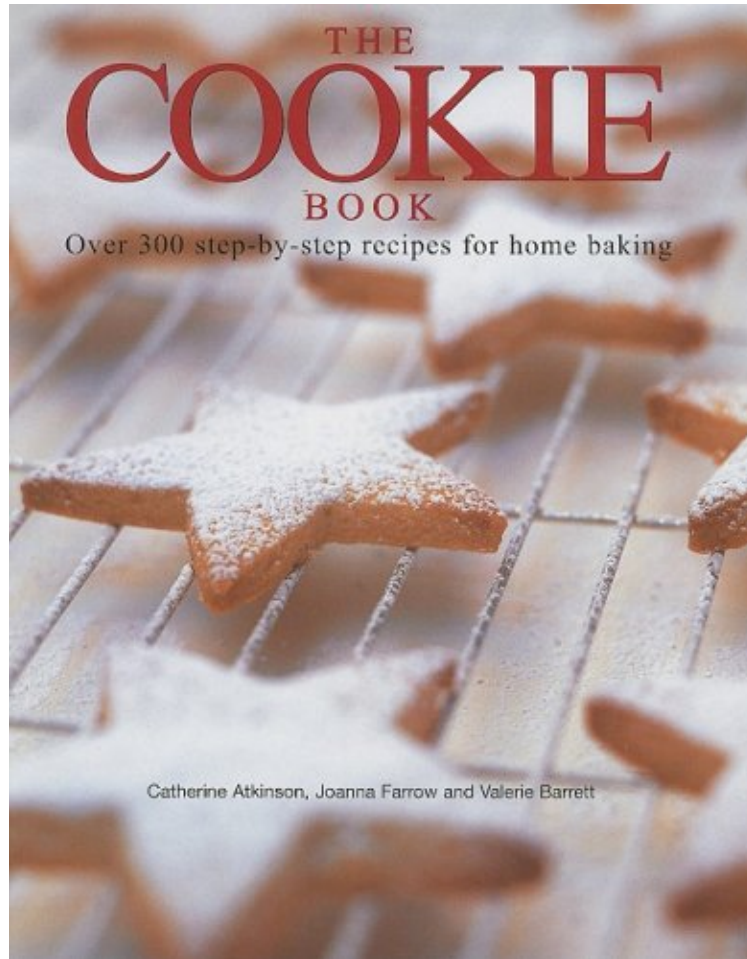

The Cookie and Biscuit Bible By Nubia Poorly written book and seems like recipes were not reviewed. I tried making the Butter Cookies, which seemed like a pretty easy recipe. Recipe calls for 3/4 cup butter and 1/2 cup sugar (beat until smooth and fluffy) and 2 1/4 cups of flour. There should be a "smooth dough" when you add the flour to the butter/sugar mixture and you should be able to shape into a log, but this is not possible. The thing just crumbles. I tried making them twice because I thought "maybe I did not mix the butter and sugar long enough" but it just seems like an ingredient is missing. Looked up other recipes online and they call for eggs for this type of cookie. What a disappointment. The picture are nice..... that is all :(0 of 0 people found the

For some of the recipes (hamentaschen, linzer cookies, peanut butter cookies, ginger cog-wheel cookies) they are a little different from the standard and come out better than what I can find from professionals at the bakery. The book does not get a perfect rating because there are a few (and I do mean very few) recipes that need modification in order to work. Though I must say I did not have the experience of the other reviewer with the chocolate chip cookies-- I am not sure if she has a different version of the book because I found that recipe to actually be a standard tollhouse cookie recipe, and works just fine. But overall it has a huge variety of delicious, creative cookie recipes that have an excellent variety of flavours and presentations.
