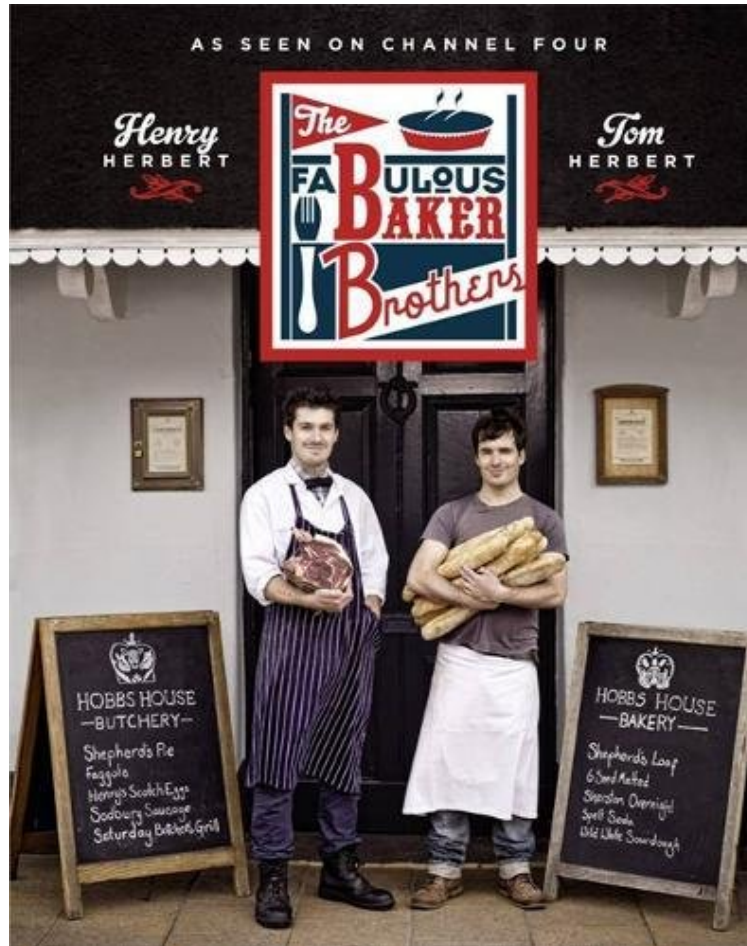

Thus it has reading value as well as reference value. I imagine that as time goes on I will return to this book when I need something, for the family, yet something also they may not have tried, but which won't create too many waves at the dining table. So, yes I like the idea behind the book and the book itself, so it's worth four stars. The book is graphic heavy, but on a colour tablet looks nice. One note: I don't believe in docking stars for the format a book comes in, but it should be noted that this book is only available in a limited number of formats which are basically tablets. I use several kindle reading clients and not being able to read the book on my phone (which is normally where I read recipes from) is an issue I'm not overly happy about. If I have paid attention to this when buying the book, I'd have probably had serious reservation about the purchase and probably not bought it.
