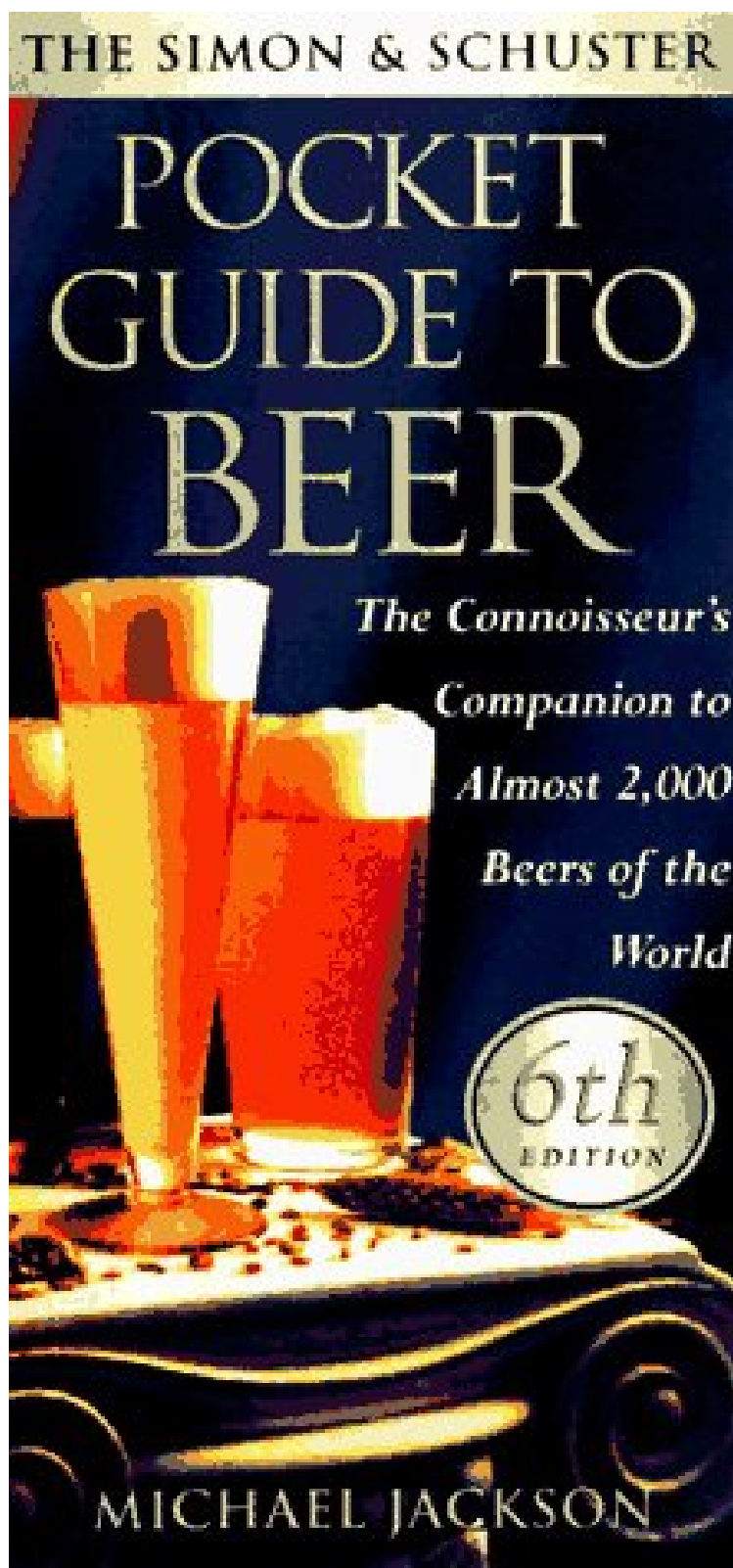

Woefully out of date but still fun By P. Mulloy This book accompanied me on several trips to Europe from its original publication in 1986 through the fifth edition published in 1996. I wore out several. As well as listing and rating various brewers of note and their beers, it also includes a "where to drink" section for each major city. The older editions contained more "where to drink" info and guided to the marvelous Cafeacute; Mort Subite off Grande Place, and Ultieme Hallucinatie (316 rue Royale) (an incredible art nouveau cafeacute; featuring Cantillon), in Brussels, as well as several bars featuring trappist beers, a place serving over 500 beers in Antwerp, and the Cafeacute; Golem and de Wildeman in Amsterdam as well as a brew pub serving all of the craft beers brewed in the Netherlands. The older the edition, the better the list but then also the better the chances the place will be there.
