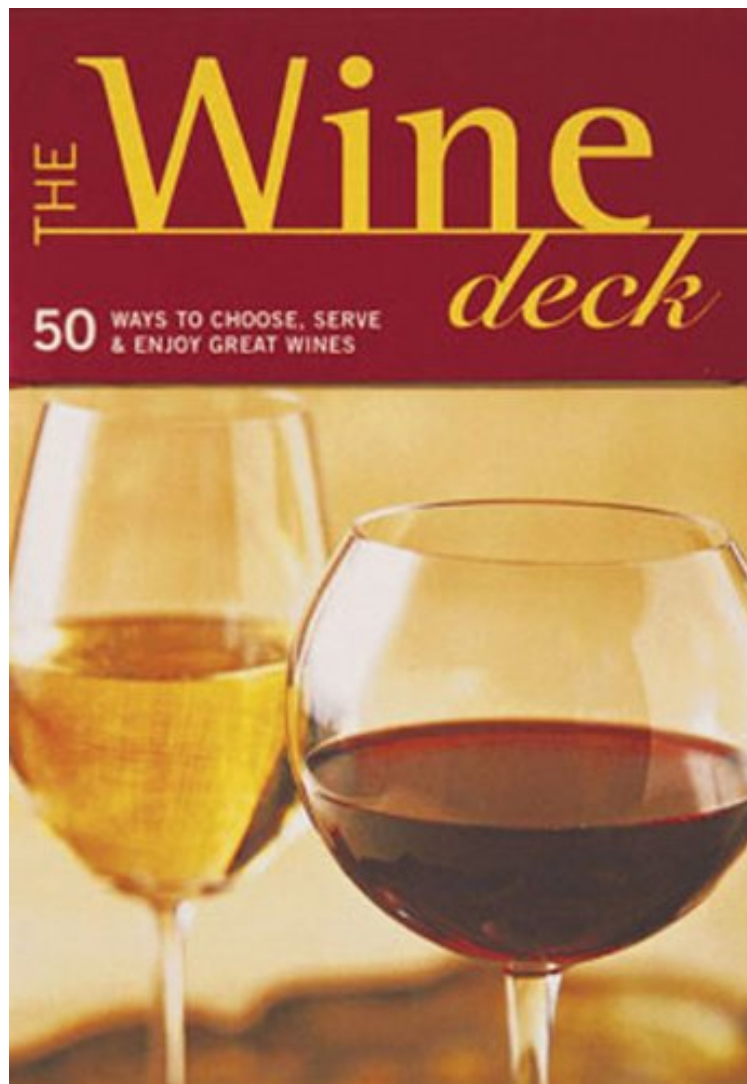

The Wine Deck allows you to quickly look up a particular kind of wine, or choose "ideal" wines to go with whatever you're cooking and serving. The deck format makes it easy to shuffle through to find whatever information you are looking for. The deck also provides other basic information, such as the "right" serving temperature for each kind of wine. You won't be an expert, but this provides easily accessible information that demystifies choosing (and buying) wines.

Are you curious about wine, but can't tell the difference between a Pinot Noir and a Sangiovese? A Chenin Blanc and a Chardonnay?
