the recipes. They are recipes for dishes that perhaps a generation or two ago every householder would have known, at least the way their mothers made them. But over time, as the focus has shifted away from cooking, this basic knowledge seems to have been lost, and so for the likes of my husband and myself, who found ourselves far from home and longing for the taste of home food, this book proved to be a Godsend.
